I am the leading scientist for INRAN in the project. I am responsible for the Work Package on Flavourings. The project deals with methodological aspects in exposure assessment and not with specific substances to be discussed at the CEF Panel. The payment for this research project is being made to my employer and I do not have any financial benefit from it.</p>

An exercise of refined exposure assessment was performed on 4 flavouring substances: raspberry ketone, coumarin, glycyrrhizinic acid and caffeine.
